We request you to kindly note the following Tournament details: -

1. DATES OF TOURNAMENT:

17th October to 20th October 2011 (Both days inclusive)

2. REPORTING DATE:

Teams have to report before 05:00pm on 16th October 2011. Managers meeting will be held at 07:00pm on 16th October 2011.

3. VENUE:

The tournament will be conducted in Jain International Residential School (JIRS) campus. The school is situated 45 kms from Bangalore city railway station on Kanakapura Main Road.

4. TEAM STRENGTH:

Every School will be entitled to enter a team of maximum four players in U-12,U-14, U-16 & U-19 age group separately in Boys' & Girls' category.

In addition, each school is entitled to send a maximum of 04 staff (coach / manger) in case both boys & girls teams are participating. The managers and coaches have to stay with their teams and no separate accommodation will be provided.

5. ELIGIBILITY FORMS:

Duly filled entry forms as per enclosed format must reach the undersigned on the address mentioned at the end of the letter by **25 Sep 2011**. Under no circumstance on the spot entry or late entry will be entertained. Further, postal delay will not be considered as an excuse for late entry. Teams should submit all relevant documents of participation as stipulated by CBSE Board to the organizers on arrival. Teams without proper eligibility forms will not be allowed to participate in the tournament.



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6. OPENING AND CLOSING CEREMONIES:

The inauguration of the tournament will be held on 17th October 2011 morning and closing ceremony will be on the evening of 20th October 2011. The programme for both ceremonies will be intimated in the managers' meeting.

7. ACCOMMODATION:

Furnished dorms will be provided to all outstation teams inside the campus. Separate accommodation will be provided for Girls' teams. Only lady managers and lady coaches will be allowed to stay in girls' accommodation area. Male managers accompanying girls' team will have to stay in boy's accommodation area. Managers and Coaches are to bring a letter of authorization duly signed by the principal. A limited number of bed sheets / blankets etc. can be provided by the school. Accordingly it would be better if the children brought their own beddings.

8. FOOD:

Nutritious and delicious vegetarian food will be served at a reasonable price of Rs.175/- per day per head, which includes morning milk, breakfast, lunch, evening snacks and dinner. Coupons will have to be purchased by the team managers in advance every evening for the following day. Coupons once purchased will not be taken back. Please note that **non-vegetarian food (including eggs) is not allowed inside the campus.**

9. TRANSPORTATION:

Transport will be provided only from Bangalore City Railway Station and Yeshwantpur Railway Station to JIRS on 16th October 2011 on request. The buses will leave for school campus from Railway Stations (Opposite Kempe Gowda Bus Terminal & Yeshwanthpur Rly Stn.) at the following timings: -

1st Trip – 08:00am

2nd Trip – 12:00 noon

Last Trip – 04:00pm

A Performa for travel plan is enclosed with this letter.

Teams are requested to inform the exact date & time of arrival / departure to enable the organizers to receive / depart the teams at railway stations. If the teams do not inform their travel plan, we will not be able to arrange for transport from Bangalore to school and back. Teams traveling by any other mode must reach Bangalore City Rly. Stn. under their own arrangements to avail school bus pick up facility.

10. CAUTION DEPOSIT:

A deposit of Rs. 1000/- per school will be collected at the time of reporting and the same will be refunded after deducting damage charges, if any, when the team vacates the premises. Any damage caused to the property during



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the stay by any participant has to be compensated by the concerned school.

11. THINGS TO BE BROUGHT BY THE PLAYERS:

12. THINGS TO BE BROUGHT BY THE TEAM MANAGERS:

- a. Proof of payment of Annual Mandatory Sports Fee to CBSE 2011-12.
- b. Eligibility forms as per format provided by CBSE.
- c. Valid Identity cards of accompanying officials
- d. Group photo of team with Principal
- e. School flag – 2 nos.
- f. Lock and key

IMPORTANT POINTS TO BE NOTED:

- Participants are requested not to bring valuable items such as Jewelry, Camera, and Walkman etc. If such things were brought, it would be at their own risk.
- The managers will be responsible for the safety of the belongings of their teams.
- The school will not be responsible for any illness, injury or accidents, which occurs during the sports meet. However the school has a full-fledged Medical Clinic managed by qualified Physicians round the clock.
- Schools are requested to make their own arrangements for return journey reservation.
- Events will be conducted as per the format provided by CBSE. Chief Judge will be the overall in-charge for the conduct of events.
- The dos & don'ts along with the rules and regulations of the tournament will be provided to the managers before the managers' meeting.

Rules and Regulations

1. The competition will be conducted according to the rules and regulations of the swimming Federation of India (SFI) unless otherwise modified by CBSE Board, New Delhi.
2. In under 12 years age group, a swimmer can participate in maximum three Individual events and in relays.
3. In under 14 years age group, a Swimmer can participate in maximum four Individual Events and in relays.
4. In under 16 & 19 years age group, a Swimmer can participate in maximum five Individual events and in relays.
5. Every school will be entitled to enter only one competitor in each of the following events.
6. No team will be allowed to participate without a team manager or Coach.
7. In case there are less than four swimmers present for a particular event, it will be conducted and the swimmer will be awarded the medals and the merit certificate but the points will not be included for awarding individual or team championship. The name of the first and second winning swimmers will be forwarded for participation in National level.



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8. The decision of the referee on all technical aspects will be final.
9. Protest regarding any event should be made within 1 hour of the completion of the event, duly accompanied by a fee of Rs. 500/- (Five hundred only) to the organizing secretary which will be refunded if the protest is upheld.
10. A separate prize will be given to the individual Champion for boys and girls section, in all the age categories. For deciding the individual champion, the performance in the individual events and individual medley will be taken into consideration.
11. A prize will be given to the school scoring 'total maximum points' and will be declared as 'overall champion'.
12. If all the five members of the relay team have registered their name in this eligibility Performa and have attended the meet irrespective of who swims, they will be awarded medals and certificates if they win.
13. Each participant will be provided with a participation certificate by CBSE Board.
14. All the first three position winning swimmers will be awarded merit certificates by CBSE Board.
15. The team Manager / Coach is requested to ensure that the teams maintain strict discipline in the pool and within the campus.
16. Heavy fine will be levied if damage is caused to the school property.
17. Smoking is strictly prohibited inside the organizing school campus.
18. On arrival at the organizing school, the teams have to report to the Reception.
- 19. Participation in March past is compulsory failing which their right to participate will be forfeited.**
20. Under any circumstances on the spot entry and late entry will not be entertained.
21. The last date for receiving detailed entry forms / documents / travel forms is on or **before 20th September 2011.**
22. The teams arriving by train or bus will be received at the Railway station or Bus stand.
23. A meeting with the managers and coach will be held on 16rd October 2011 at 500pm in the school Sprintoor.
24. All Protests / disputes at the venue will be referred to the Jury of Appeal for a final decision.
25. Their Decision on all matters will be final and binding on all participants / Coaches/Managers.
26. The Organizers reserve the right to debar a participant / Coach /Manager from the competition arena for unruly behaviour / interference in the smooth conduct of events of the competition.
27. In such cases the aquatic complex may be temporarily placed out of bonds for those participants /Coaches /Managers.
28. In case of continued unruly behaviour /interference in conduct of the competition, the concerned school may be disqualified from the Event /entire competition at the discretion of the Jury.

The championship will be decided separately in boys and girls section. The points shall be awarded to the team have according to the point systems as per the following criteria as adopted by S.F.I.

Thinks to be Brought by them Managers and Coaches

1. Each team must bring 2 school flags, one would be required for the march past and the other would be hoisted on the inaugural day at the venue.
2. All the participating teams (swimmers) must have their own '**School Identity Card**' giving all the details (Name, Date of Birth, Class, Admin No. , Events, and (photography) duly attested by the head of the institution.
3. **Attach photocopy of class X passing mark sheet / class IX registration certificate of the participant with the Performa.**
4. **Each team will have to produce a group photo of the team with team coach manager and the Principal of the school which should be duly attested by the Principal on the back side.**
